Our Fantasy Camp is an action-packed week of baseball skills development for deaf, hard-of hearing, and speech-impaired children in Kindergarten through Grade 8. Skills are taught by high-school coaches and student players who understand the needs of the kids. The camp is held at the Standard Bank Stadium, the home of the Windy City Thunderbolts, in Crestwood, IL. Every session is staffed with sign-language interpreters and special-needs providers, who are always on the field to relay instructions or lend a helping hand. Everyone— all the staff, coaches, volunteers — work together to ensure a fun, motivating, and enriched, learning environment.

Please Note: Although our camp is focused on children who have speech and hearing impairments, siblings without impairments are also welcome to attend.
